Injury to others in the vicinity			Care should be taken to adhere to the manufacturer's guidance and keep the strimmer clean. Ensure all machine checks are a carried out before beginning work. Use only two-stroke fuel and replenish it outside.		
			The strimmer should be kept clean and used according to the manufacturer's schedule and be maintained by an qualified service agent (currently GBC).		
			Strimming must not be done in close proximity of other site users.
